



Marine Department Notification

Subject: Policy of not accepting neither gifts nor profits from performing duties

(No Gift Policy)

Fiscal year B.E. 2569 (2026)

According to Section 128 of the Organic Act on Anti-Corruption B.E. 2561 (2018), “Public officials are prohibited from accepting assets or any other benefits which may be calculated in monetary value from any person except for the assets or benefit which may be entitled to such persons under the laws, regulations or rules permitted by virtue of law, unless the acceptance of assets or other benefits is on an ethical basis under the criteria and amount as prescribed by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC).”

In compliance with the provision of the Act, to enhance the organizational culture and norms in honest, ethical and responsible performing of duties, Marine Department declares that **“Marine Department’s executives and officials shall not accept or provide presents and gifts of all kinds, before, during, or after performing duties from internal and external personnel, persons in contact and stakeholders, which would cause corruption and misconduct at the present and in the future”**, as well as comply with the ethical standards for officials and build public confidence in the official upholding the principle of good governance.

In this context, Marine Department officials mean government officers, permanent government employees, government employees, temporary government employees, and contractors who shall strictly comply with such policy. If Marine Department officials are found to be violating or not complying with such policy, the case can be directly reported to the Director General of the Marine Department for consideration of appropriate disciplinary actions.
